- ✓ All students, faculty, staff and community members are welcome to climb.
- ✓ Regardless of what skill level you possess there are always climbing wall supervisors to help you prepare for your climb during normal hours of operation.
- ✓ All children of members are encouraged to try the climbing wall regardless of age.
- ✓ Youth recreation hours have been established for participation.
- ✓ In order to become a belayer the climber must successfully complete a safety and skills test.
- ✓ Participants must be at least 16 years of age to take the safety and skills test to become an approved belayer.
- ✓ Climbing shoes or athletic shoes are required at all times. No bare feet or hiking boots are permitted.
- ✓ All climbers must use ARC provided belay devices, carabiners and ropes. There will be no exceptions to this policy.
- ✓ Participants may use their own harness provided a climbing supervisor inspects it and a personal harness waiver is signed.
- ✓ Helmets are highly recommended, however should the participant choose not to wear the helmet they must sign a Release Waiver.
- ✓ No loose chalk is permitted. Climbers may use a chalk ball.
- ✓ Climbers and belayers are responsible for double checking each other's safety systems prior to each climb.
- ✓ Belayers must belay from their harness and not the floor anchors.
- ✓ No swinging across the wall.
- ✓ Climbers must climb in designated areas.
- ✓ No bouldering above or below another climber or boulderer.
- ✓ Climbers and belayers must use correct communication commands.
