Webelo Woods is a camp out designed to introduce Webelos to the many outdoor adventures of Scouting. This awesome weekend event includes patrol-method camping and Scout activities. On Saturday morning, Webelos formed in patrols will visit skill stations like first aid, fire building, camping skills and knots provided Scouts BSA Troops teaching these Boy Scout skills.

- The theme this year is high flying adventures. We are joining the Forks of the Delaware district scouts in their “Anything that Fly’s” Camporee. These activities will be open to Scouts that register on their site, and Webelos with some restrictions.
- Webelos Woods is an ideal chance for Webelos to camp with Scouts BSA troops!
- Webelos will camp as a patrol with a host Scouts BSA Troop.
- Webelos will learn Scout skills from Scouts BSA members while having fun with competitions and activities on Saturday.
- Webelos will experience the thrill of preparing meals and camping with your host Troop.
- Food will be coordinated with your host Troop.
- The Saturday night campfire will include skits and songs.
- Parents of Webelos Scouts will learn about transitioning to Scouts BSA and tips on what to look for in a troop.
- Webelos are encouraged to contact a partner troop.

There are plans for a Pancake Breakfast on Sunday at Camp Trexler that you can also sign up for. This is of course optional and has an additional fee. More details on that as they appear.

Registration

The registration fee is \$10 per person. Late registration is \$12 and begins 10/1/19. Registration can be made with “Anything that Fly’s” for Scouts and Webelos that which to participate in that event as well. Dual registration is not required but contract with the organizer for camp space is required. There is no onsite registration.
